

Summary

As we arrive at the midpoint of 2025, we take a moment to reflect on the progress made during the first half of the year. These past months have been defined by meaningful engagement, strong community support, and a deepening of Planet Inaba's mission to foster education, dignity, and collective resilience.

One of the most exciting developments has been the launch of the High Atlas Library Project—an ecological initiative aimed at expanding the educational reach of the Maggie School. Designed to welcome nearly 200 children, this future library is more than a physical space; it carries symbolic weight, inspired by the word "Iqra" (Read), the first command in the Qur'an, and grounded in our vision of inclusive learning.

In parallel, preparations are underway for a cultural exchange experience that will allow volunteers to contribute directly to the library's construction while discovering the cultural richness of the Atlas region. Although dates are yet to be confirmed, the interest and anticipation surrounding this program are already strong.

Our Orphan Sponsorship Program in Gaza also continues to grow, thanks to the unwavering support of our donors. Currently, six orphans receive monthly support through this initiative, which has raised over €6,400 to date. This project stands as a testament to the power of consistent, human-centered aid.

We've also seen remarkable momentum through creative fundraising. In collaboration with Schattig Café, we hosted a vibrant community event featuring a live painting session by artist Ismail Matar. His work was later auctioned online to support Palestinian aid, with the initiative raising more than €2,296. This event captured the spirit of solidarity, artistry, and purposeful giving.

Another milestone was the debut of our INABA merch collection, a limited release of ethically made sweaters and hoodies that reflect our values of empowerment, inclusion, and identity. The campaign not only helped raise funds but also fostered a stronger visual identity and deeper connection within our community.

As we move into the second half of the year, we remain energized by the collective strength of those who walk alongside us. Every action, whether in the mountains of Morocco, the communities of Gaza, or the hands of supporters around the world—continues to shape a future where education and solidarity are at the heart of sustainable change.



Supporting Gaza Aid

In 2025, Planet Inaba deepened its commitment to supporting children affected by conflict through the continuation of its Orphan Sponsorship Program in Gaza. In a region marked by instability and hardship, this initiative offers consistent, meaningful support to some of the most vulnerable members of the community.

Thanks to the generous contributions of donors, Planet Inaba has successfully raised €6,400 to date. These funds are used to provide monthly sponsorships covering essential needs such as food, clothing, healthcare, and access to education.

As of now, the program is actively supporting six orphans, ensuring that each child receives personalized, ongoing assistance. This support does more than meet basic needs—it offers emotional stability, educational continuity, and a renewed sense of hope.

The organization sees this project as a long-term commitment, not a one-time act. By inviting donors to stay involved over time, Planet Inaba is building a sustainable bridge of care, where children are not only protected but also empowered to grow and thrive.



Planet Inaba's commitment to sustainable change was clearly demonstrated through its community-based fundraising efforts and strategic collaborations in 2025. One of the key moments of the year was a successful event hosted in partnership with Schattig Café just before Eid el Adha.

This heartfelt gathering brought together supporters, volunteers, and artists for a cause greater than just fundraising it was a celebration of community, solidarity, and shared values. A special thank-you was extended to Schattig Café for their alignment with Planet Inaba's values of social justice, creativity, and sustainable development.

During the event, Planet Inaba ambassador and talented artist Ismail Matar created a symbolic piece of artwork live on site. This unique piece not only captured the spirit of the evening but also became a powerful symbol of hope and unity.

Following the event, an online auction was launched to sell the artwork. The starting bid was set at €375, and all proceeds were dedicated to supporting Palestinian aid. This auction added an additional layer of impact to the event, ensuring that the spirit of giving continued beyond the physical gathering.

Through this fundraiser, Planet Inaba successfully raised €2296.02. The full amount was allocated toward the construction of the library in the High Atlas Mountains of Morocco a space for more awareness for reading, education and opportunity.



High Atlas Library Construction & Cultural Exchange Trip

This project is rooted in both infrastructure and imagination a space where young minds can read, dream, and learn. The library aims to serve 198 children, offering them access to books, knowledge, and a quiet, inspiring environment to study and growth. It is more than just a physical space t's a symbol of resilience, literacy, and future-building.

To bring this vision to life, Planet Inaba is preparing an immersive program combining construction, volunteering, and cultural exchange. Volunteers from around the world will be invited to participate in a unique experience that includes:

- Helping build the library side-by-side with locals
- Facilitating creative activities for children
- Sharing meals and moments with the local community

In addition to the hands-on impact, participants will enjoy cultural exposure including a visit to Marrakech, exploration of Moroccan traditions, and bonding over authentic cuisine and storytelling.

The program is expected to cost €1399, which will include flights, local transfers, accommodation, breakfast, and all meals during the stay in the Atlas.

By building this library, Planet Inaba isn't just laying bricks it's planting seeds for generations of learners.











INABA Merch Launch: Sweaters & Hoodies

As part of its 2025 fundraising strategy, Planet Inaba launched its first-ever line of branded merchandise an initiative that combines **art with a purpose**. The **INABA merch collection** was designed not only to generate financial support for ongoing projects but also to strengthen the foundation's identity and visibility among its growing global community.

This initiative centered around the release of **unisex sweaters and hoodies**, carefully crafted to reflect Planet Inaba's core values: **inclusion**, **empowerment**, **and identity**. Each item in the collection was designed to carry a message one of solidarity, impact, and belonging.
